

Listening Ear service through Contact for families with disabled children



If you need to talk to someone who understands the extra challenges you face as a parent or carer of as child with additional needs and who can point you in the right direction to get the support you need for your family.

Contact for families with disabled children offer 1-1 telephone appointments with a family support adviser for parent carers looking for a listening ear, reassurance and practical and emotional support.
