Hi parents and carers!

Hope you're all keeping well?

I have attached on the website set 2 and set 3 read write inc sounds

The idea is your child focusses on one sound a week

I have made a list of what set to focus on with your child

Set 2- A.S, A.W, C.S.W, C.R, R.W

Set 3- L.M, M.C, B.M, S.S, M.B

Ways to make phonics fun!

Once you have practised the sound

Go on a treasure hunt

Write down and hide the sound, can your child find it and say it?

Can your child spell a word with their new sound in?

Say, cover, spell and check, turn it into a game!

Make a sensory tray

Hide the written sound in a tray, fill with sand or cereal anything messy!

Watch alphablocks!

Write out key words and sounds with a paintbrush and water in the garden, draw sounds in the sand, clap syllables of a word, if you have magnetic letters ask your child to spell out the different words.

Go on a "sound" walk around your home, what can you see what sounds are in the names of your household items?

Make a wordsearch

Make a flip flap book with your child, great practice and a useful resource to keep, write different letters and cut through the middle to make different words.
