Paper to draw your pig

A plastic sealable bag

Foam

Brown paint



Use brown paint and get your child to dip there toy animals in the paint and make “muddy” paw prints on paper.



Take your learning outside

Go into your garden and dig in the mud, can you find any mini beasts?

Go outside and splash in muddy puddles just like Pepper Pig, remember to wear your wellies?

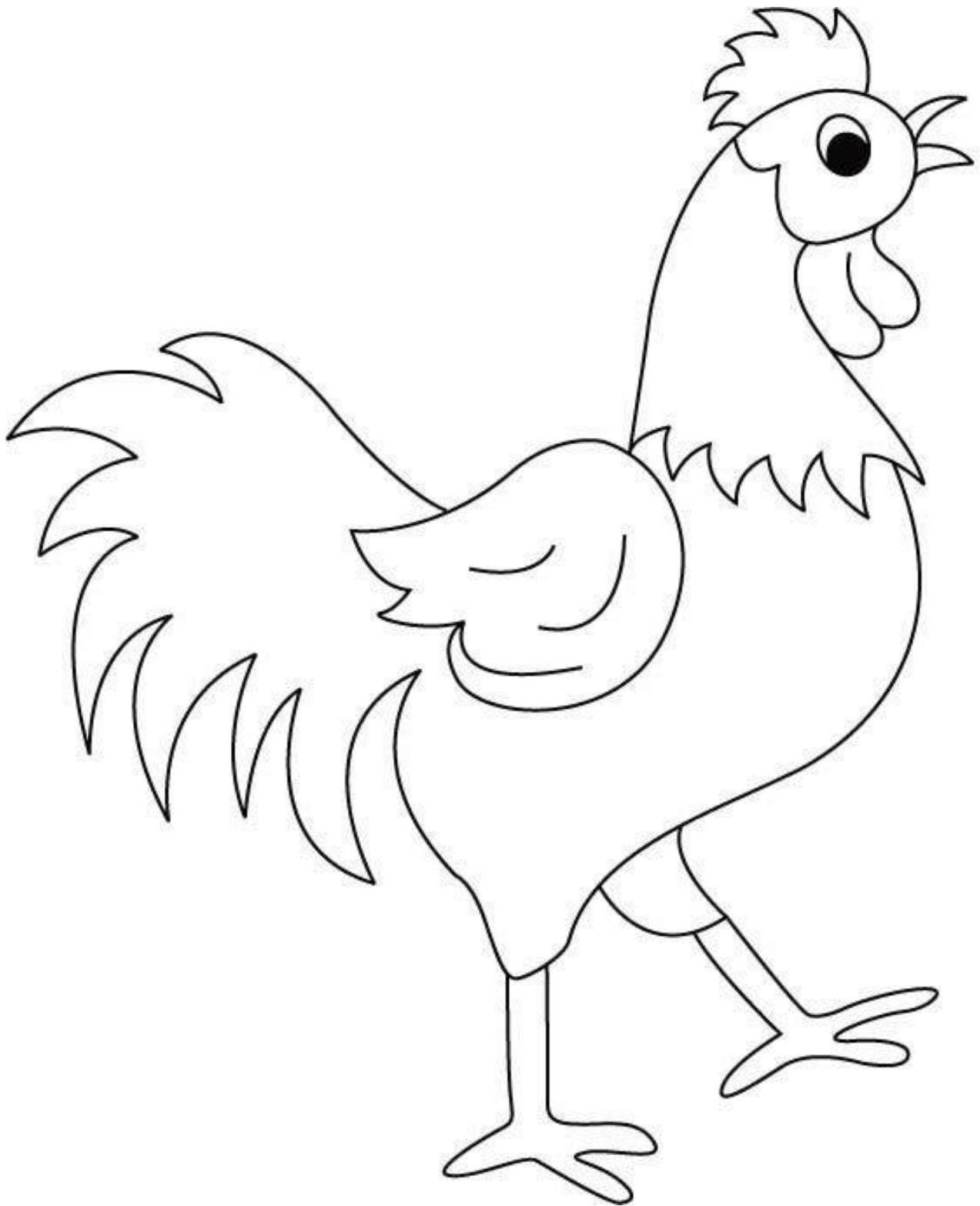
Go on a colour hunt in your home/ outside, how many different colours can you find?
