Resources required for this story:

The Easter Story Sensory Story Supporting PowerPoint, tablets/other devices, variety of stones/pebbles, toy animals/puppets for each animal in the story, metal armour/shield, leaves/sugar paper/hand-held fans, wooden claves/coconut shells, coins in purse/bag, napkins, bread, blackcurrant juice, selection of flowers and grass, bandages, angel wings.

Use relevant signs and symbols throughout to support your pupils.

Story	Suggested sensory resources	Activities
Jesus arrived in Jerusalem in a donkey. People covered the path with palm leaves and shouted 'Hosanna'	Claves/coconut shells. Toy animals/puppets for donkey. Use tablet to make animal noises. Large leaves/large sheets of sugar paper/hand-held fans to wave. Tablet with 'Hosanna' prerecorded.	 Pass round the claves/coconut shells to make clopping hooves noise for the donkey. Pass round and feel the toy donkey. Take turns to press the switch/tablet with animal noises or encourage children to make/sign animal noises. Fan children or children fan each other (where appropriate) with large leaves, sheets of sugar paper or create breeze with hand-held fans. Take turns to press tablet with recording of 'Hosanna' or encourage children to say/sign 'Hosanna'.
Judas betrayed Jesus for money.	Real coins or role-play money in a drawstring- bag/purse.	Pass round the purse – shake, feel and handle the coins.

Story	Suggested sensory resources	Activities
Jesus sat down to a Passover meal with his friends. Jesus shared the bread and wine at the Last Supper. He told his friends he had been betrayed.	Circle of chairs or carpet space to make a circle.	Sit all children in a circle as though sat round a table.
	Napkins per child. Bread per child (where appropriate/allergies depending). Juice in cups per child. Tablet with 'I have been betrayed' pre-recorded.	 Pass round napkins for children to place on their laps or support children in doing so. Pass around bread to taste (where appropriate); encourage children to share the bread in half. Pass round blackcurrant juice (to look like wine) to drink. Take turns to press tablet/switch with recording of 'I have been betrayed' or appropriate shildren to say (sign the look).
Jesus said that Peter would deny him before the cock crows.	Tablet with 'I will be denied by Peter' pre-recorded. Toy animals/puppets of hen/cockerel or a bag of soft feathers.	 encourage children to say/sign the key phrase. Take turns to press tablet/switch with recording of 'I will be denied' or encourage children to say/sign the key phrase. Children feel the toy/puppet or immerse hands in the bag of soft feathers.
Jesus prayed in the garden of Gethsemane.	Range of flowers for different scents and grass.	 Children to put hands together, lower hands and pretend to pray (where appropriate). Children feel and smell the different scents of flowers and grass (where appropriate).
Judas told the high priests where Jesus was and they sent the temple guards. Peter said he didn't know Jesus.	Metal armour or shield. Children to march. Say/sign/shout 'Help!'.	 Pass round metal armour or shield to feel. Children to march like soldiers (where possible). Children could also swing arms and tap feet on floor to make marching sounds. Say or sign 'Help!'.

Story	Suggested sensory resources	Activities
The cock crowed.	Toy animals/puppets of a hen/cockerel or bag of soft feathers. Tablet with cockerel crowing sound pre-recorded.	 Pass round the toy/puppet or feathers to feel. Take turns to press tablet/switch with recording of cockerel crowing or encourage children to make crowing noises.
Jesus carried the cross to the hill. Jesus was put on the cross and left.	Wooden cross or pieces of smooth wood. Children stamp feet on floor for walking steps.	 Pass round wooden cross to feel the shape or pieces of smooth wood. Encourage children to make heavy, walking steps with their feet.
Jesus was put in a tomb, which was covered with a large stone. On the third day the stone was rolled away. An angel said that Jesus had risen.	Stones or pebbles. Bandage arms or legs/ deep pressure massage. Pair of angel wings or feathers. Tablet with 'Jesus has risen' pre-recorded.	 Children feel different sized stones and pebbles of different textures. Bandage arms/legs (where appropriate) or apply a deep pressure massage. Pass round a pair of feathery angel wings - feel/try on the wings. Take turns to press tablet/switch with 'Jesus has risen' recorded.
