CH2 4EU This seminar is for all parents and carers of children and young people with autism who would like to know what they can do if their child is excluded from school, or is at risk of exclusion. The talk will cover official exclusions (fixed period and permanent), but also informal (unlawful) exclusions, internal exclusions, part-time timetables, managed moves and the exclusion of pupils on the autism spectrum from school trips and afterschool clubs.
