Here are the suggestions and the schools response.

The school could have more funding	Our funding is provided by the government and linked to the number of children on roll. We always take advantage of any grants that we can apply for also.
There were more after school clubs	After school clubs will resume in September 2022 as will the after school family swimming lessons.
The school has more staff	From September we will continue to have 1 teacher and 3 TA's in each classroom.
The school runs summer camps	Holiday provision is led by Halton Disabled Children Services. This is something that we will continually review.
Method of seeing what children do daily through an online system / see for ourselves what the children do in class.	As a school we use a system called Evisense. Your log-ins will be resent out. This allows you to view photos / video of your child's work. Additionally we share children's activities through social media, our website and newsletters as well as your daily emails.
Visitors such as police and fire brigade came to school	This is an activity that does take place across the year; we have links with our local emergency services and NHS and periodically they come to school. Also we have visits from other groups within the community and use our minibus to explore the local area.
The school expanded and taught high school age as well	Unfortunately our designation is only Primary age and there are no plans to expand!
More hands on support from SALT / OT's / Physios.	We work closely with Chatterbugs who are in school up to 2 days per week and with the OT / Physio team whenever a child requires their support. If anyone feels their child needs a referral please do get in contact. Additionally we commission 2 days of additional speech and language and a sensory OT for 1 day per week.
More of a focus on health issues.	As per above we work closely with all healthcare providers including holding all Ophthalmic clinics in school. If anyone feels their child needs a referral please do get in contact.
Daily communication via books or email was sent out quickly from child leaving school.	This should be the case that once the children have left the teachers will email. On occasions where they have meetings / training straight after school these may be delayed. Urgent messages will always be telephoned home.

I extend my thanks to those parents who provided responses to the surveys and hope that I have been able to address any issues raised.
