Autism Friendly sessions include:

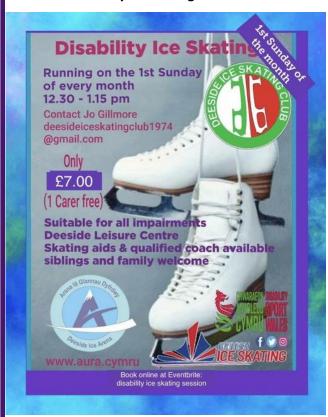
