### **Halton** Local Offer

#### What are the benefits for completing the surveys?

In December 2023, the service will be submitting an application for a grant to improve the SEND system in Halton. By participating in this survey you will help to

provide the SEND and Inclusion Service with a clear picture of your thoughts about the effectiveness of the SEND support children and young people receive in Halton.

Your information will tell them what is currently working and what areas may need improvement. The more feedback they receive – good or bad – the greater our prospects of improving services in the future.
