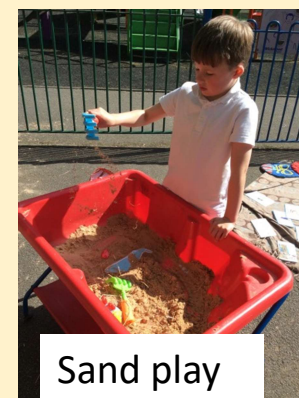

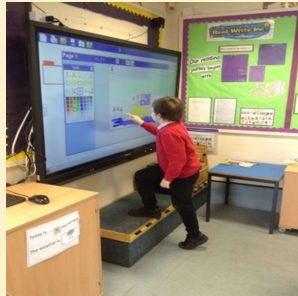

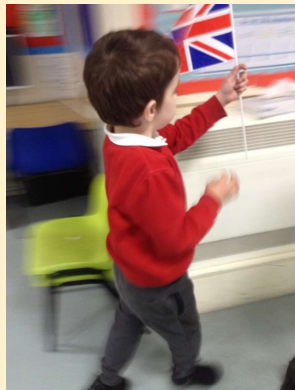
Squirrels

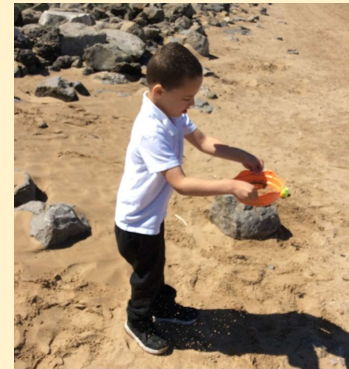
Squirrels have certainly enjoyed this lovely weather during this summer term. Squirrels team wish everyone a safe and happy summer holiday! Have fun.

Summer Term in Woodpeckers

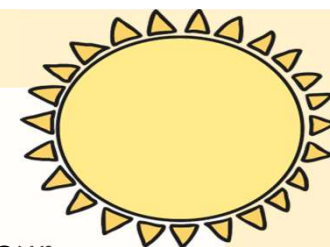

Amongst many other skills, we were learning to keep ourselves safe when walking by the road as well as in the class and whilst playing outside.

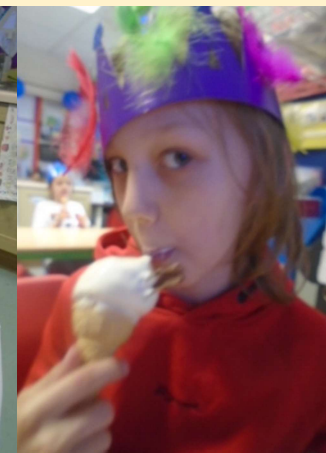
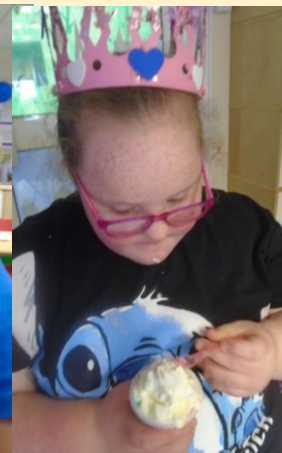
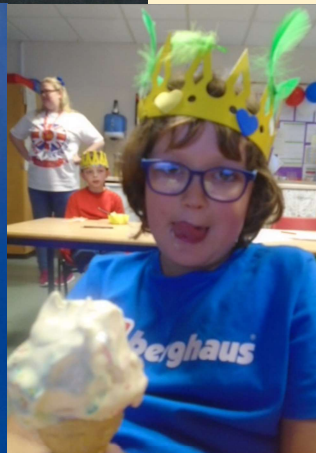
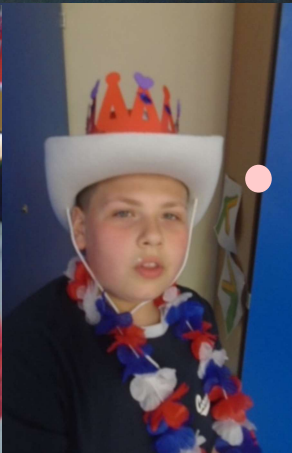


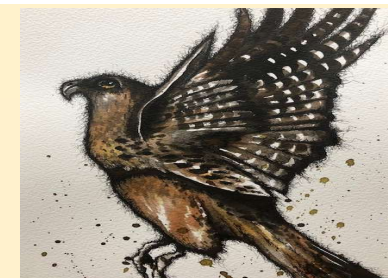
