We used magnifying glasses, sensory trays, musical instruments, straws in water, chopping fruit and the foot spa.



Squirrels are all getting ready for Christmas with themed activities. We have been doing lots of arts and crafts ready to take home .











As part of our topic work we have been learning about separating materials through sieving and filtering and evaporation.




