Decorated Elephant Handprint

Supplies

- Paint
- Sequins or acrylic jewels
- Paper
- Glue
- Shallow tray or paper plate
- Pens
- Wobbly/googly eyes



1 First, paint your hand using a brush or press your hand into a shallow tray of paint. Then, press your hand onto a piece of paper and allow to dry. Don't forget to wash your hands!



2 Turn the paper so that the fingers of the printed hand are pointing down. Stick on or draw, an eye and an ear. A tail could also be drawn or painted on.



3 Next, begin adding some decorations. Stick on a square of coloured paper and sequins to be a decorated blanket on the elephant's back and also add some sequins or jewels onto the elephant's face and body.
