You Will Need:

- · An empty milk carton
- Felt-tip pen
- Scissors
- White glue
- Googly eyes
- Paintbrush
- Tissue paper (in different colours or with a pattern)
- Ribbon







1. Draw a line just under the handle of the carton.



5. Using the glue, stick your squares of tissue paper onto the carton so that they overlap each other.



2. Cut along the line and continue cutting around the carton until you have cut off the bottom half.
You may need an adult's help.



6. Continue sticking on the squares until your whole elephant is covered in paper.



3. Draw an arch on each side of the carton and one on the back of the carton (on the opposite side to the handle). Cut these out to make the legs.



7. Stick on the googly eyes (one on either side of the handle). If you do not have any googly eyes, you can draw some on using a felt-tip pen.



4. Cut your tissue paper into small squares.



8. On the opposite side to the handle, add a tail, using a small length of ribbon.

Top Tip: Tissue paper works best but thin, coloured paper will do if you don't have any.
