

Pudsey Says

Communication and Language Game

Instructions

You will need:

- Action Cards
- Small bag or box



How to play:

- Place all of the cards into a small bag or a box. You will see there are two sets of cards – some with a yellow border and some with a red border.
- Choose an adult to read out the Action Cards. The adult should stand at the front and everyone playing the game should stand in a space.
- The adult reading the cards should pick a card from the bag to read to the group. If the card has a yellow border and begins with the words 'Pudsey says...', the group should complete the action.
- However, if the card has a red border and does not start with the words 'Pudsey says...', the group should not complete the action and instead, should remain standing still.
- Used cards should be placed back into the bag to be used again. Continue to choose cards and challenge the group to complete the correct action or to remain still.
- If a member of the group performs the incorrect action, they are out of the game and should sit down. Continue until only one or two members of the group remain. The winners could be given a sticker for their super listening skills, before a new game begins.
